- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for Nov. 1, 2016 was called to order at 7:20pm following an Executive Session.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a common victualler's license for Lamp and Dragon at 41 Main Street.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the contract with Advocates, Inc. for Behavioral Health Treatment Court Collaboration.
- The BOS conducted a public hearing for an application for an on premise all alcohol license for The Revival Pub at 25 Main Street. License approved the by BOS (3-0).
- The BOS heard an update from the DPW Superintendent on the recent Pan Am diesel fuel spill and clean-up.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a reduced sewer connection fee for existing residents in the amount of \$2,000 for a period ending July 1, 2017.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a contract change order in the amount of \$31,541.95 for the Pleasant Street Reconstruction Project.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the pre-engineered garage at Grove Pond Water Treatment Plant Agreement in the amount of \$308,986.00.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a contract change order in the amount of \$8,993 for the West Main Street Wastewater Pumping Station.
- The BOS heard a presentation from the Nashua River Watershed Association and the Ayer Town Administrator regarding a status report of the Nashua Wild and Scenic River Study.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize the full-time hours and benefitted status for the Conservation Agent (funding previously approved by Town Meeting on October 24, 2016).
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the meeting minutes from October 18, 2016.
- The BOS adjourned (3-0) at approximately 9:10pm.
