#### **Board of Selectmen Meeting Summary and Highlights from October 6, 2015\***

- The October 6, 2015 BOS Meeting was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS approved (3-0) the Drug Advocates Contract.
- The BOS approved (3-0) a Class II Motor Vehicle License Application for the Power of Honesty, Inc. located at 179 West Main Street.
- The BOS heard a facility update from Mr. John Hillier of Central Ave. Compassionate Care where he indicated they plan to open for patients (all by appointment only) by late October/early November.
- The BOS authorized (2-1) a letter of non-opposition for medical marijuana cultivation only to Seven Point of Massachusetts, Inc. for a proposed cultivation only facility to be constructed at 99 Fitchburg Road.
- The BOS met in Joint Session with the Finance Committee to review the Fall Special Town Meeting Warrant. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Fall Special Town Meeting Warrant for October 26, 2015 at 7pm in the Great Hall of Town Hall.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to execute the layout of Calvin Street Ext., Blueberry Circle, Hibiscus Lane, Mulberry Circle, Magnolia Drive, and Samantha Lane for consideration by Town Meeting to be adopted as public ways.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Transfer Station Paving Contract as well as the Transfer Station Concrete Pad Construction Contract. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Washington Street Water Main Replacement Contract.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint Ms. Susan Tordella to the Comprehensive Plan Committee.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a proposed Sexual Harassment Policy and a proposed CORI Policy to be sent to the Personnel Board to initiate the process of incorporation into the Town's Personnel Policies.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the BOS Meeting Minutes from September 15, 2015.
- The BOS adjourned at approximately 10pm.
