The Board met with Chairman Hamel, Selectman Slarsky and Selectman Miller.

The Board met with the Ayer School Committee: Chairman Armand Guarino, Members: William Noeth, Russell Brown, and Kathleen Kidder.

Chairman Hamel opened the discussion by stating the purpose of the meeting this evening being to vote with the School Committee to fill the vacated seat of Steven Wells. Chairman Hamel stated the School Committee had three candidates wishing to fill this vacancy: Roland Cooper, Viola Barnes and Reverend Ted Turnley.

Selectman Slarsky requested the three candidates be nominated. Selectman Slarsky moved to nominate Viola Barnes, Roland Cooper and Ted Turnley, 2nd by Armand Guarino.

Selectman Slarsky moved secret ballots be cast regarding the election of the three candidates, 2nd by William Noeth. Mr. Guarino presented the ballots to the Selectmen for distribution.

Chairman Hamel stated the Board's secretary, Janet Lewis would do the counting and announcement.


Mrs. Lewis stated seven (7) ballots were cast and reflected four (4) votes for Viola Barnes and three (3) votes for Roland Cooper.

Ms. Viola Barnes was voted to fill the unexpired term of Steven Wells, on the Ayer School Committee effective until the next Town election in April 1995.

Ms. Barnes to be notified by both the Board of Selectmen and School Committee upon her election to the Ayer School Committee.

Selectman Slarsky moved to adjourn, 2nd by Selectman Miller, Vote: unanimous, so moved.
