## \*Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for June 21, 2016

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for June 7, 2016 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS recognized the Ayer Shirley Regional High School Music Program.
- The BOS heard Public Input from the ASRSD regarding a request for a waiver to water the new high school hydro-seed between the hours of 9am and 12pm. BOS voted (3-0) to grant the waiver subject to review on July 12, 2016.
- The BOS heard a report from the Fourth of July Committee and recognized Ms. Dottie Marino as the 2016 Ayer Fourth of July Parade Grand Marshall.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the purchase order in the amount of \$67,756 for the DPW Wastewater Utility Truck. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the purchase order in the amount of \$142,235 for the DPW Sidewalk Snow Blower/Mower.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the sale of the DPW Freightliner (surplus property) in the amount of \$42,800 to Wall Truck and voted (3-0) to approve the sale of the DPW Trailer/Tank (surplus property) in the amount of \$10,277.79 to Westside.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Complete Streets Prioritization Plan Engineering Agreement in the amount of \$49,900 with Worldtech.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the East Main Street Contract Changer Order #1 in the amount of \$33,807.22 (funding covered by the USDA Grant).
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a contract amendment in the amount of \$34,220.71 with Ti-Sales for water meters, radios and related equipment.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the MUNIS Contract on recommendation by the Town Accountant in the amount of \$119,364.00.
- The BOS heard a request from the Conservation Commission regarding increasing the Conservation Agent's hours to full-time.
- The BOS heard an Administrative Update from the Town Administrator to include a project update on the Ayer Commuter Rail Surface Parking Lot and Access Improvement Project as well as the Chapter 61 Nashua Street Extension Appraisal Process.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve various appointments and reappointments to the Town Boards, Commissions, and Committees as presented and recommended by the Town Administrator.
- The BOS discussed with the Parks Department the future replacement of the playground at Pirone Park.
- The BOS adjourned (3-0) at 9:00pm from Open Session.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, July 12, 2016 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
