- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for August 15, 2017 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS took Public Input from Residents regarding ongoing odor complaints from Nasoya and heard from representatives from Nasoya. The BOS has put this item on the September 5, 2017 BOS Meeting Agenda for further update/discussion.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint the Administrative Coordinator.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint a part-time Dispatcher and a Special Police Officer on recommendation of the Police Chief.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the purchase and sales agreement for the 1934 Historic Fire Station with Donnell Builders.
- The BOS reviewed the Central Avenue Heavy Commercial Vehicle Exclusion Study as prepared by the Town Engineer and voted (3-0) to authorize the Town to make the formal request to MassDOT for a Heavy Commercial Vehicle Exclusion (24 hrs) for Central Avenue.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to open the Special Fall Town Meeting Warrant for the October 23, 2017 Special Fall Town Meeting at 7pm in the Auditorium of the Ayer Shirley Regional High School (Deadline for Citizens Petitions to the Town Clerk is 12pm on Friday, October 6, 2017)
- The BOS heard a proposal from the Town Administrator for the reorganization of the Town's Government by home rule petitions to be placed on the Special Fall Town Meeting Warrant for October 23, 2017.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the July 18, 2017 Meeting Minutes. The BOS voted (3-0) to adjourn the meeting at 9:34pm
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 at 7pm at the Aver Town Hall
