*Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights from February 4, 2020

- The Ayer BOS Meeting was called to order in Open Session at 6:00pm in the First Floor Meeting Room of the Ayer Town Hall.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Release of Certificate Not to Encumber for 57-61 Main Street on recommendation of the Office of Community & Economic Development.
- The BOS received and Administrative Update from the Town Manager which included a review and discussion of the Town's Downtown Parking Plan as administered by the Chief of Police in consultation with the Town's various Public Safety Departments. The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint Mr. Scott Murray of Ayer as an "Associate" (non-voting) of the Ayer Conservation Commission. The BOS voted (3-0) to issue a letter of non-opposition for the KENO To Go for Alltown Fresh located at 28 Harvard Road in Ayer.
- The BOS received an update from Selectman Houde regarding the Executive Bi-Board. The BOS received an updated from Selectman Houde regarding a recent meeting with the ASRSD regarding next steps with respect to the High School Field Project.
- Selectman Livingston discussed with the BOS the idea of having the annual Water and Sewer Rate
 Public Hearing as its own meeting as opposed to being part of the BOS Meeting as in previous years.
 The goal would be to focus on the Water and Sewer Rate Public Hearing at a stand-alone meeting
 and to increase public attendance and participation. The BOS concurred with this proposal.
- Selectman Copeland discussed with the BOS the idea of recognizing a school group at the next BOS Meeting. The BOS agreed and discussed recognizing more students, scouts, and citizens for various achievements at future BOS Meetings.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the meeting minutes from January 21, 2020.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to adjourn the meeting at 6:50pm
