- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for February 6, 2018 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS observed a Moment of Silence in memory of Dispatcher Victoria Roche.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to issue a letter of support for the Sandy Pond School Association's Community Preservation Fund application.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize the FY 2018 CDBG Grant Application and to issue a letter of support for the grant application.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update and FY 2019 Budget Update from the Town Administrator.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to reappoint the Animal Control Officer for a one year term to expire on December 31, 2018.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a PILOT Agreement with Citizens Energy for the solar array to be constructed on the capped municipal landfill site.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the January 23, 2018 BOS meeting minutes.
- The BOS received a report from the DPW Superintendent regarding the proposed DEP Drinking Water Rule Change and the PFAS Issue.
- The BOS met with State Senator Jamie Eldridge to discuss various issues, state legislation, and projects of importance to the Town of Ayer.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to adjourn the meeting at approximately 9:30pm.
