*Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for January 23, 2018

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for January 23, 2018 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS recognized Mr. Nick Laggis and his Family for over one hundred years of business on Main Street for the P.N. Laggis, Co.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to appoint an Assistant Town Accountant on recommendation by the Town Administrator and Finance Manager.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to execute the contract for the Radio Infrastructure Improvement Project in the amount of \$567,181.00 with Timberline Communications.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to appoint a full-time Dispatcher on recommendation by the Police Chief.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the contract for the East Main Street Final Design in the amount of \$135,000.
- The BOS received an update from the DPW Superintendent on the Town's Wastewater Inflow/Infiltration (I/I) Study.
- The BOS received an update from the DPW Superintendent regarding various proposed projects at the Carlton Circle Rotary.
- The BOS authorized a letter for support for an MRPC District Local Technical Assistance Grant to study water resources and groundwater supply in Ayer.
- The BOS discussed various other DPW project updates with the DPW Superintendent.
- The BOS received a presentation and overview of the proposed Zoning Bylaw Update from the Town Planner.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update and Update on the FY 2019 Budget Process from the Town Administrator.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to open the 2018 Annual Spring Town Meeting Warrant (Note: The deadline for all Warrant Articles, including Citizens Petitions will be Fri. April 13, 2018 at 12pm noon.)

- The BOS voted (2-0) to adopt and implement G.L. c. 32B, Sections 21-23 for the purposes of negotiating the FY 2019 health insurance plan design changes with the Town's Insurance Advisory Committee.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve and sign the following document s for the transfer of the Rail Trail Lot from the State to the Town for the purposes of the Ayer Commuter Rail Parking and Access Improvement Project: Memorandum of Understanding; Boundary Line Agreement; Release Deed; and Disclosure Statement.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the BOS Meeting Minutes for January 9, 2018.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, February, 6, 2018 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
