***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for January 3, 2017**

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for Jan. 3, 2017 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve and issue a Declaration of a State of Emergency pursuant to G.L. c. 44, sec. 31 regarding the McNiff Farm at 66 Westford Road for the purposes of paying the emergency bills incurred by the Town for the abatement and remediation of the property as authorized by the Middlesex Superior Court.
- The BOS took questions and comments from the Public in attendance regarding concerns over the McNiff Farm located at 66 Westford Road.
- The BOS received a public update from the Town Administrator regarding the Town's ongoing property enforcement measures underway at 66 Westford Road to abate and remediate the nuisances and dangerous conditions at the property. The BOS took questions and comments from the Public. The BOS issued two public records requests to the MSPCA and the State Department of Agriculture requesting all of their inspectional reports and documents related to 66 Westford Road.
- The BOS appointed (2-0) Police Lt. Gill as the Police Department's Records Access Officer on recommendation of the Town Administrator and Police Chief.
- The BOS approved (2-0) the Meeting Minutes for December 8, 2016. The BOS adjourned (3-0) the meeting at approximately 8:20pm.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
