***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights from March 4, 2020**

- The Ayer BOS Meeting was called to order in Open Session at 6:00pm in the First Floor Meeting Room of the Ayer Town Hall.
- The Ayer BOS recognized the students of the “Ayer Fab 5” for their dedicated community service and volunteerism to the Town of Ayer.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the application for change of manager for Shaker Hills Country Club.
- The BOS met with Ms. Jessica Strunkin, Senior Vice President for Devens regarding MassDevelopment’s plans for the rezoning of Vicksburg Square.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to execute the contract for the FY 2020 Water and Drain Improvements in the amount of \$254,847.52 to Cedrone, Corp.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update from the Town Manager.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint Ms. Carole Tillis of Ayer to the COA Board of Directors.
- The BOS received a FY 2021 Budget Update from the Town Manager and Finance Manager. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a FY 2021 2% Cost of Living Adjustment for all non-union employees and elected officials. The Town Manager presented an overview summary of the DRAFT 2020 Annual Town Meeting Warrant. The Town Manager discussed the Town Hall Employee Training Schedule with the BOS.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the meeting minutes from February 18, 2020.
- The BOS voted (3-0) by roll call vote (Houde Y; Livingston Y; Copeland Y) to enter into Executive Session pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, Section 21A, Exemption #3 (Contract Negotiations) Fire Contract and Town Hall/Clerical Union Negotiations Update and to adjourn for the evening at the conclusion of the Executive Session.
