- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for May 3, 2017 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint the position of Assistant Tax Collector on recommendation by the Tax Collector.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Town Counsel Consent and Disclosure for KP Law to work on the Groton Inter-Municipal Agreement. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Town of Ayer and Town of Groton Inter-Municipal Agreement for the Four Corners Sewer District subject to legal review by Town Counsel.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the DPW Superintendent's trash bag fee recommendations for the Transfer Station.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a Wastewater Reserve Fund Transfer in the amount of \$20,000.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Ayer Youth Works Program for the DPW and to accept the gift of \$26,000 from Central Ave Compassionate Care to fund the program.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update from the Town Administrator. The BOS voted (3-0) to reappoint the Veterans Affairs Agent on recommendation from the Town Administrator for a one-year term per MGL.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize a BAN issue and refunded bond issue on recommendation by the Town Finance Manager and Town Treasurer.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the April 18, 2017 BOS Meeting Minutes.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to enter into Executive Session and to adjourn for the evening at the conclusion of the Executive Session.
