### **\*Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights from September 18, 2019**

- The Ayer BOS Meeting was called to order in Open Session at 6:00pm.
- The BOS presented a 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Proclamation to the Nashoba Valley Technical School District in recognition of their fifty years of vocational education to the Nashoba Valley.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to call a Special Election to take place on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 to fill the vacancy on the Board of Selectmen.
- The BOS received a presentation of the proposed West Main Street Form-Based Code from the Director of Community & Economic Development. The BOS received a Master Plan Quarterly Update from the Director of Community & Economic Development.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update from the Town Manager which included an overview of the proposed Special Fall Town Meeting Warrant Articles to date; a discussion of the DRAFT FY 2021 Budget Calendar and a debrief of the September 11, 2019 Finance Committee Meeting. The Town Manager also announced that the Town has received a \$174,576 competitive Green Communities Grant from the DOER for various Town energy projects.
- The BOS received a debriefing from Selectman Livingston of the September 10, 2019 Rate Review Committee and a debrief from the Devens Jurisdictional Framework Committee Meeting.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to authorize a letter of support for legislation filed by State Representative Sheila Harrington seeking to make the Devens Museum the official military museum on Devens.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the meeting minutes for September 3, 2019. The BOS voted (2-0) to adjourn the meeting at approximately 7:15pm.
