


## Ayer Board of Selectmen

### \*Meeting Highlights from February 2, 2016



- The Ayer Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 7pm by Selectman Livingston.
- There was no Public Input.
- The Board approved (3-0) the Award of the East Main Street Water and Sewer Improvements Contract in the amount of \$1,079,576.50 as presented by the DPW Superintendent.
- The Board approved (3-0) the deed of sale for the former Central Fire Station (14 Washington Street) in the amount of \$60,000 to GS Holdings.
- The Board appointed (3-0) Ms. Karin Swanfeldt to the Master Plan Committee as recommended by the Town Administrator.
- The Board reviewed and discussed the DRAFT Town Meeting and FY 2017 Budget Calendar.
- The Board heard an update on the Willow Road/Rt. 2A Intersection project from Selectman Hillman. Mass Highway will be installing temporary signalization at the intersection for the Summer of 2016 with a permanent solution to be designed and constructed.
- The Board heard an updated on the FY 2017 Nashoba Valley Technical High School Budget Assessment from Selectman Luca.
- The Board approved (3-0) the January 19, 2016 Meeting Minutes.
- The Board adjourned (3-0) at approximately 7:45pm from Open Session to convene into an Executive Session.
- The Board will next meet in a Special Joint Meeting with the Finance Committee to hear an FY 2017 Budget Presentation from the Ayer Shirley Regional School District.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Ayer Board of Selectmen will be on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall.
