Explanation of Request:	The existing security gate at the DPW is a manual operated steel gate painted yellow. There is also a rolling chainlink gate that is never used because it is heavy, non-functioning, and gets blocked by snow.
	The manaully operated gate has issues: requiring yearly painting and maintenance, pinch points (DPW has had injury incident reports), and requires individuals to exit vehicles and manually open under all weather conditions. The existing gate is locked outside normal DPW hours (Mon-Fri 7:30-3:30) and anyone entering the facility must open and close the gate, including police and fire for fueling. The industry standard is to have an automatic security gate which can operate off-hours via identification cards. An automatic gate will eliminate safety issues with manual operation and track personnel entering and exiting the facility.
Cost Justification:	The price is based on a quote from a vendor who specializes in this type of work.
Benefit to the Town:	Provides more secure DPW yard and fueling station, improves safety concerns
Alternative:	Continue to use manually operated gate

Explanation of Request: The Ayer DPW updated the pavement management plan in 2021 using a software called Predictor. We currently reconstruct / repave roads and sidewalks using MassDOT Chapter 90 funds. Ayer's current allocation in approximately \$240,000 per year. Our pavement management plan provides a Pavement Condition Index - PCI for each street ranging from 0 (poor condition) to 100 (newly paved). A streets have an average PCI of 73. A PCI of 80 is considered acceptable. If we continue to use only Chapter 90 (i.e. \$240,000 per year the model indicates the PCI will reach a plateau of 77. A budget of \$325,000 will raise the PCI to 80 after by 2029 which can then be maintained with the Chapter 90 budget.				
Cost Justification:	The budget is based on current paving bid prices with a construction inflation factor.			
Benefit to the Town:	Maintain the Town's infrastucture on an annual basis and provide the town with safe transportation.			
Alternative:	Rely on Chapter 90 funding only and apply for other grants when available.

The Dike is on Town ROW property. Some Phase 3 work is inlouded in the DPW capital budget, however MassDOT may also be scheduling this work.
