RE: Proposed Purchase of Tooker Property, Oak Ridge Drive

The Ayer Conservation Commission (ConCom) is requesting that the Ayer Community Preservation Committee (CPAC) recommend at Fall Town Meeting that up to \$ 130,000 be allocated to the ConCom for the purpose of purchasing the real estate shown on Assessors Map 21, parcel 46 (attached), located at or about 50 Oak Ridge Drive and presently owned by Mr. Al Tooker, for open space and recreation purposes. This property would be permanently held as conservation land for the good of all citizens of Ayer.

This property represents a unique opportunity for the town of Ayer to extend existing conservation land encompassing Pine Meadow Pond, and create an additional trail access to that property from Oak Ridge Drive. This is consistent with Ayer's Comprehensive Master Plan as the property will be protected and remain as open space where it may otherwise have been lost to development. The property represents a significant upland area above Pine Meadow Pond, further protecting that wetland resource. The addition of this 5.5 acre parcel would increase the town's significant holdings at Pine Meadow Pond and allow for the extension and creation of trails and walk paths for our residents. By supplementing the existing trails this parcel provides the community with greater continuous recreation space. This particular property becomes more valuable to Ayer when one considers that the vast majority of property surrounding this conservation land is already developed with residential homes. This remaining forested parcel is a great example of what is important in our drive to preserve open space and create recreation area for all our citizens. The BOS-appointed, volunteer members of the Conservation Commission, as well as a local attorney, are willing to donate their time and effort to seeing this project through.

The timeline for the project started with a 6-13-09 meeting on site with the owner of the property, Mr. Al Tooker. Mr. Tooker communicated to the ConCom through his realtor that he is willing to sell the property to the town of Ayer, and is willing to wait until after the Fall Town Meeting to do so. On 6-23-09 ConCom representatives attended a meeting before the Board of Selectmen. At that meeting the BOS spoke in support of this project and voted in Executive Session to approve the use of \$12,000 in UDAG funds to accompany an offer to purchase to Mr. Tooker, thus securing the land for the town until after Fall Town Meeting (FTM). On 6-25-09 the ConCom formally voted in Executive Session to support this project, and to move forward with this application.



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The timeline going forward involves several public meetings by the ConCom and before the CPC to create public awareness and build support. The ConCom will also speak again before the BOS and introduce the purchase at those hearings as well. We look forward to speaking at FTM in October and helping Ayer's citizens understand how important this land is for them and their children.

Upon a successful town meeting vote the ConCom would look to CPC to provide funding to perform the critical background work on the parcel, such as survey, checking title, and performing a Phase 1 analysis. All of these steps are designed to protect the town from adverse consequences that could evolve upon ownership. The work would occur in November of 2009.

If all goes well with then we would anticipate closing on the land as soon as the money becomes available, likely in January of 2010. All work on the property is planned to occur in FY2010.

The Conservation Commission and Board of Selectman support this project because it will add to existing open space surrounding Pine Meadow Pond and adjacent to Flannagan's Pond. The project protects land which might otherwise be developed and maintains upland areas above a wetland resource. The land will provide both open space and recreation area, linking existing trails and allowing for the creation of new ones. Last, this forested property represents one of the last undeveloped areas on Oak Ridge Drive available for purchase. The Conservation Commission respectfully requests your support of this project.
