
Who to Interview

Equipment to Bring to Interview

- Digital recorder, iPhone, or iPad with voice recording app such as Audio Memos
or
Video recorder with microphone (do not use Voice Activation feature)
- Interview guide
- Pen and paper
- Camera
- Biography Sheet
- Informed Consent Form – 2 copies. Interviewee keeps one copy
- Deed of Gift - 2 copies. Interviewee keeps one copy
