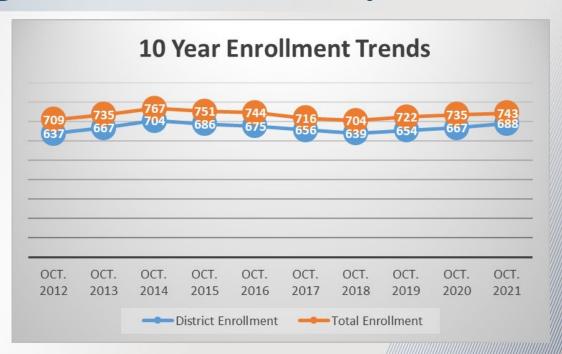

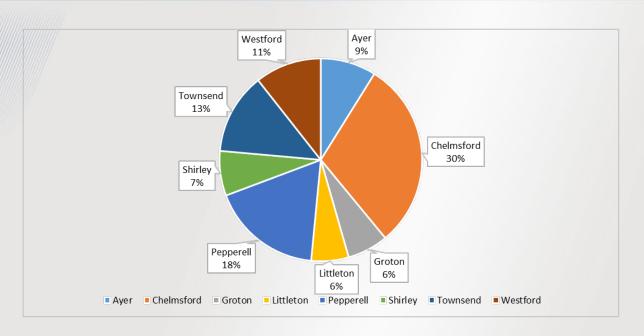
Enrollment Change at Nashoba Valley Tech

FY23 Enrollment compared to FY22:

- ➤ Increase of 8 students overall (from 735 to 743 students)
- ➤ Increase of 21 district students (from 667 to 688)
- Decrease of 13 school choice students (from 62 to 49)
- No change in non resident enrollment (from 6 to 6)



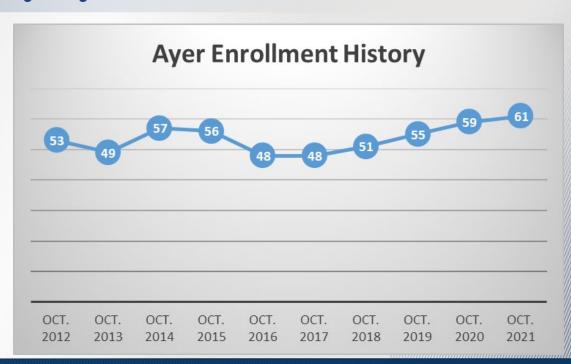

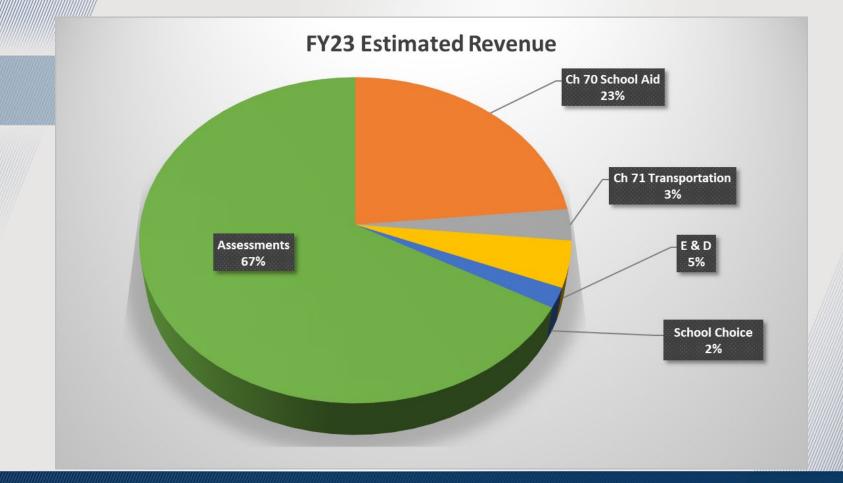
