- 1. Review and approve minutes from April 3, 2019 meeting (attached to email)
 - a. Done
- 2. Updates from Laurie
 - a. Meeting with Robert about plastic bag reduction
 - i. There is pending legislation at the state level.
 - b. Harvard recycling meeting
 - c. Continuation of social media/newspaper PR campaign: can be very productive, wish I had more time to spend on it
 - d. Mailer sent a few months ago with sewer/water bill
- 3. Business cards: Janice
 - a. LS will look into
 - b. Do we need to have them adhere to town standards?
 - c. Should be included, name of committee, email address, printed on recycled paper
- 4. Bottle/can recycling: Becky
 - a. Andrew agrees that it can take place at the Transfer station, at the far end. Will have two signs: one generic for the program and one specific to the organization that is currently benefiting.
 - b. Someone (not at the school level) will have to coordinate. Becky volunteered to coordinate the first year. Becky suggests contacting scouts, civic groups, school groups, sports groups. Needs PR/talking points: ties community together, educating about redeeming, increases the amount of these things that might be recycled. Laurie and Becky will meet.
 - c. Becky will meet with the town accountant, find out from Andrew when the space will be available. Supplies such as rain cover, gaylord boxes are needed. Could there be a second drop-off location for people who don't use the TS?
- 5. Recycle Your Reusables activities
 - a. Volunteers
 - i. 34 currently signed up. Last year about 75 were on hand. Few high school students have signed on yet. I've had some limited success with groups: First Parish Church of Groton, Boxboro Sustainability Committee, Harvard UU church.
 - b. Vendors
 - i. All vendors are confirmed. Laurie reviewed the new vendors this year.
 - ii. Concern about media recycling/reuse: MTW will take VHS tapes for recycling @ \$10/box. Laurie will confirm all formats that MTW will take (either for reuse [free] or recycling[\$\$])
 - iii. If we have the funds and the need, we'll buy a 3rd Terracycle media box.
 We agreed that for Terracycle media, we'll accept a shoebox-sized box

for \$5. In the next email update, Laurie will feature this and ask for feedback.

- c. Fundraising
 - i. Janice has prepared a fund-raising plan and will begin contacting businesses and other organizations very soon.
- d. Local arrangements
 - i. What to do about water.
 - ii. I double-checked and Loaves and Fishes has been confirmed.
- e. RYR future
 - i. If we have small numbers again this year
 - 1. Figure out why?
 - 2. Cancel it
 - 3. Do it the same way
 - 4. Focus on reuse
 - 5. Join forces with another town

 - v. Laurie will promote and ask for feedback about media storage options at RYR.
