***Ayer Select Board Meeting Highlights from December 5, 2023**

This meeting of the Ayer Select Board was held in-person at the Ayer Town Hall with a remote participation option on Zoom for the Public.

- The Select Board (SB) Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm in Open Session.
- The SB heard a request for reimbursement for a sewer connection fee for 236 Snake Hill Road which had been TABLED from the November 21, 2023 meeting. The SB voted (3-0) to authorize a \$3,000 abatement for the sewer connection fee.
- The SB conducted the FY 2024 Tax Classification Hearing. The SB voted (3-0) to not adopt an Open Space Discount. The SB voted (3-0) to not adopt a Residential Exemption. The SB voted (3-0) to not adopt a Small Commercial Exemption. The SB voted (3-0) to adopt a Residential Shift Factor of 0.7427 and a CIP Shift Factor of 1.66 for FY 2024 which translates to an estimated Residential Tax Rate of \$12.25 and an estimated CIP Tax Rate of \$27.38 for FY 2024.
- The SB voted (3-0) to approve the 2024 License Renewals on recommendation of the Assistant Town Manager.
- The SB received an Administrative update and an update on the FY 2025 Budget Process from the Town Manager. *(Note: FY 2025 Budget information and documents can be found on the Town's website at www.ayer.ma.us/budget or on request from the Town Manager's Office)*
- The SB voted (3-0) by Roll Call Vote to enter Executive Session Pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, Section 21A, Exemption #6 (Consider Acquisition of Real Property) 71 Sandy Pond Road; and Exemption #3 (Litigation Strategy) AFFF/PFAS Litigation and to adjourn for the evening at the conclusion of the Executive Session.
