## \*Ayer Select Board Meeting Highlights from November 1, 2022

This meeting of the Ayer Select Board was held in-person at Town Hall. Members of the public attended in-person as well as remotely. An option for remote attendance/participation via Zoom was provided as a courtesy to the public.

- The Ayer Select Board (SB) Meeting was called to order in Open Session at 6:00pm.
- The SB voted (2-0) to approve the Change of Manager Request from Global Montello Group Corp d/b/a Alltown Fresh Ayer 29 Harvard Road, Ayer.
- The SB received an update on the Sandy Pond Schoolhouse project from Mr. Irving Rockwood.
- The SB received an update from the DPW Director on the Town's Drought and Water Supply Status. The SB voted (2-0) on recommendation of the DPW Director to end the state of water conservation for the Town at this time.
- The SB received an Administrative Update from the Town Manager on the various activities, initiatives, and projects of the Town since the SB last met on October 4, 2022. The SB voted (2-0) to appoint Amanda Lewis, Benefits and Payroll Manager as the primary representative of the Town to the Minuteman Nashoba Health Group. The SB voted (2-0) to appoint Onyinyechi Njoku to the Ayer Cultural Council.
- The SB voted (2-0) to discount all licenses under the SB by fifty percent (50%) for Calendar Year 2023 to provide partial ongoing relief to the Town's various small businesses and restaurants due to the ongoing economic impacts from the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Under New Business the SB received an update from Select Board Member Jannice Livingston regarding the Devens Jurisdiction Framework Committee.
- The SB voted (2-0) to approve the meeting minutes for September 20, 2022 and October 4, 2022.
- The SB voted (2-0) to adjourn the meeting at 6:45pm.
