### **\*Ayer Select Board Meeting Highlights from April 2, 2024**

*This meeting of the Ayer Select Board was held in-person at the Ayer Town Hall with a remote participation option on Zoom for the Public.*

- The Select Board (SB) Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm in Open Session.
- The SB continued the Public Hearing from March 19, 2024 on the amendment to storage of flammable and combustible liquids, gases, and solids license for JAR Realty Corporation. The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to approve the license amendment.
- The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to ratify the Town Manager's appointment for Assessing Administrator.
- The SB and Finance Committee conducted a joint meeting for the final review and approval of the 2024 Annual Town Meeting Warrant for the Town Meeting on April 22, 2024 at 7pm. The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to approve the 2024 Annual Town Meeting Warrant and the Finance Committee voted (5-0) by roll call vote to recommend Articles 1 through 24 (Articles with a budgetary/financial impact) on the 2024 Annual Town Meeting Warrant.
- The SB and Finance Committee received a presentation from the Assistant Town Manager on the Town's new ClearGov Budget Platform. The Finance Committee voted (5-0) by roll call vote to adjourn from the SB meeting.
- The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to authorize letters of support for 65 Fitchburg Road, 40B Project, Ayer Commons. The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to approve the FY 2025 UDAG Budget for the Office of Community & Economic Development.
- The SB received an administrative update from the Town Manager. The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to accept an anonymous gift in the amount of \$2,000 for the Ayer Council on Aging. The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to approve letters of support for the Central Mass EMS Corp. on recommendation of the Fire Chief.
- The SB voted (3-0) by roll call vote to enter into Executive Session pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, Section 21A, Exemption #2 (Non-Union Personnel) for the purposes of reviewing and ratifying the Assessing Administrator's Contract and to adjourn for the evening at the conclusion of the Executive Session.
