*Ayer Select Board Meeting Highlights from May 3, 2022

This meeting of the Ayer Select Board was held in-person at Town Hall. Members of the public attended in-person as well as remotely. An option for remote attendance/participation via Zoom was provided as a courtesy to the public.

- The Ayer Select Board (SB) Meeting was called to order in Open Session at 6:00pm.
- The SB voted (3-0) to authorize up to \$15,000 in UDAG Funds for the further study and design of the undergrounding of public utilities on Park Street on recommendation of the Director of Community and Economic Development.
- The SB voted (3-0) to execute the 2022-2023 Paving and Road Treatment Contract on recommendation of the DPW Director. The SB voted (3-0) to proclaim May 1-7, 2022 as National Drinking Water Week in the Town of Ayer.
- The SB received an Administrative Update from the Town Manager on the various activities, initiatives, and projects of the Town since the Select Board last met on April 19, 2022. <u>The Annual Town Election will take place on Tuesday, May 10, 2022 at the Ayer Town Hall with polls open from 7am to 8pm.</u>
- The SB voted (3-0) to approve and sign the Quitclaim Deed for the Woodlawn Cemetery. The Woodlawn Cemetery Company presented the Town with a check for \$80,000 which transferred their funds in the amount of \$80,000 to the Town of which \$60,000 is for Perpetual Care and \$20,000 is for Cemetery Operations.
- The SB voted (3-0) to approve the April 5, 2022 meeting minutes.
- The SB voted (3-0) to adjourn the meeting at 6:30pm
