***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for April 4, 2017**

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for April 4, 2017 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (1-1) against the request for a Home Rule Petition for an All Alcohol Permit.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the agreement for Paramedic Intercept Services with the Town of Shirley as recommended by the Fire Chief.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the proposal submitted by C. Donell Homes, Inc. for the disposition and redevelopment of the Historic 1934 Ayer Central Fire Station on Washington Street as recommended by the RFP Review Panel and the Office of Economic and Community Development. The BOS heard an update on the Master Plan Update Process from the Economic Development Director and the Master Plan Consultant.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to authorize the refunding of past bonds as recommended by the Finance Manager and Treasurer.
- The BOS conducted the FY 2018 Water and Sewer Rates Public Hearing. The BOS voted (2-0) for a 0% increase for the FY 2018 water rates. The BOS voted (2-0) for a 3.5% increase for the FY 2018 sewer rates.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve a reserve fund transfer request in the amount of \$26,000 for the Veterans Benefits Account. The BOS voted (2-0) to approve a reserve fund transfer request in the amount of \$42,404.40 for the Building Department.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the March 23, 2017 BOS Meeting Minutes.
- The BOS adjourned (2-0) at 8:28pm.
