***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for March 20, 2018**

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for March 20, 2018 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint three full-time Dispatchers on recommendation of the Police Chief. The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint two per-diem Dispatchers. The BOS voted (3-0) to adjust the compensation for the position of Police Lt. by reclassifying the position of Police Lt. to a Grade 15, Step 9 effective immediately.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve a Reserve Fund Transfer in the amount of \$7,500 for Unemployment Expenses on recommendation of the Benefits and Payroll Manager.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to award the RFP for the sale of the Historic Fire Station to Mr. Calvin Moore in the amount of \$50,000 as recommended by the RFP Screening Committee.
- The BOS voted (3-0) on recommendation of the DPW Superintendent to grant four different sewer abatement requests. The BOS voted (3-0) to amend Section 7B of the Water Rules and Regulations as recommended by the DPW Superintendent. The BOS voted (3-0) to amend Section 10 of the Water Rules and Regulations as recommended by the DPW Superintendent. The BOS received an update and discussed the Grove Pond Well No. 8 PFAS Contamination issue with the DPW Superintendent.
- The BOS received an Administrative Update and FY 2019 Budget Update from the Town Administrator. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the FY 2019 Capital Plan/Budget as recommended by the Capital Planning Committee. The BOS received an update on the status of the Town Government Reorganization from the Town Administrator. The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the reclassification of the position of Assistant to the Town Administrator to the position of Assistant Town Manager at a Grade 14, Step 2 effective July 1, 2018 on recommendation of the Town Administrator. The BOS received an update from the Town Administrator regarding the status of various issue(s) pertaining to retail recreational marijuana.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the meeting minutes of February 13, 2018 and the meeting minutes of February 20, 2018.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to enter into Executive Session and to adjourn for the evening at the conclusion of the Executive Session Agenda.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, March 27, 2018 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
