***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for September 5, 2017**

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for September 5, 2017 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to appoint Mr. Mark Archambault as the Town Planner.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the Special Tax Assessment Agreement with American Superconductor subject to approval by Town Meeting. The BOS voted (2-0) to call a Special Town Meeting for Monday, September 25, 2017 at 7pm in the Great Hall of the Ayer Town Hall for the Special Tax Assessment Agreement.
- The BOS heard an update from the Town Administrator as well as comments from Nasoya and the Public regarding the odor issues from the Nasoya plant. The BOS will keep the item on the BOS agenda for further discussion on September 19, 2017.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the Ayer Solar Lease for the Town's capped landfill site. The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the Sandy Pond Road to Wright Road Cross Country Water Main. The BOS voted (2-0) to approve a one year extension for the Road Paving Contract. The BOS discussed the Parking Management Study and Recommendations.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to appoint Mr. Ken Diskin of Ayer as a Citizens Representative to the Town's Energy Committee.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve a one day beer/wine license for September 30, 2017 for St. Mary's Parish.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the August 15, 2017 Meeting Minutes.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to adjourn the meeting at 10:00pm.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
