Minutes of Assessors Meeting

Remote participation Open Session Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 2:04pm. Chairman Laggis, Member Wood, Clerk Maxant-Schulz, Assessing Administrator, Lynda McQuade and Assessing Department Assistant, Jacquelyn Guthrie were present.

The Board of Assessors read the agenda for November 29, 2023. A motion to approve the agenda was made by Member Wood, seconded by Chairman Laggis and approved in a 2-0. Vote: Nick Laggis: Aye; Vote: Jim Wood: Aye.

The Board of Assessors read the minutes for November 29, 2023. A motion to approve the minutes as amended was made by Member Wood, seconded by Clerk Maxant-Schulz and approved in a 3-0. Vote: Nick Laggis: Aye; Vote: Jim Wood: Aye; Vote: Ruth Maxant-Schulz: Aye.

The Board of Assessors reviewed the November and December 2023 Motor Vehicle & Trailer Excise Abatement report. The Assessing Department Assistant processed 3 abatements totaling \$343.33 for November and processed 1 abatement totaling \$15.18 in December. A motion to approve and sign the report was made by Member Wood, seconded by Chairman Laggis and approved in a 2-0 vote. Vote: Nick Laggis: Aye; Vote: Jim Wood: Aye.

The Board of Assessors reviewed the Assessing Department reports for the months of November and December. A motion to approve the reports was made by Member Wood, seconded by Clerk Maxant-Schulz and approved in a 3-0. Vote: Nick Laggis: Aye; Vote: Jim Wood: Aye; Vote: Ruth Maxant-Schulz: Aye.

The Board of Assessors was presented with a Warrant and Commitment for their approval. One Commitment number 6 for FY2023 for Motor Vehicle and Trailer was prepared. There were 292 bills totaling \$26,974.17. A motion to approve the Warrant and Commitment was made by Member Wood, seconded by Clerk Maxant-Schulz and approved in a 3-0. Vote: Nick Laggis: Aye; Vote: Jim Wood: Aye; Vote: Ruth Maxant-Schulz: Aye.

The Board of Assessors discussed the FY2024 Classification hearing held on December 5, 2023. Assessing Administrator Lynda McQuade reported to the Board that Ayer's FY2024 tax rates of \$12.25 for residential and \$27.38 for commercial\industrial\personal were certified by the Department of Revenue. There were no votes to adopt the Open space Discount, the Residential Exemption, and the Small Commercial Exemption.

Old Business:

The Assessors Department prepared one Abutters list.

New Business:

The Board of Assessors was presented with Warrants and Commitments for their approval. The FY24 Real Estate Tax Warrant and Commitment is \$15,268,736.99, the FY24 Community Preservation Act Surcharge Warrant and Commitment is \$729,570.52, the FY24 Commercial Real Estate is \$9,050,272.89. The Personal Property Tax Warrant and Commitment for \$4,256,218.60. The FY24 Water and Sewer Lien Warrant and Commitment for \$83,010,.50 Motion passes by a vote of 3-0. Vote; Nick Laggis: Aye Vote; Ruth Maxant: Aye. Vote; James Wood: Aye.

There were no issues of old business.

At 2:27 pm, pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, sec. 21 (a)(7) G.L.c.59, sec.60 and G.L.c.214 sec. 1B, in connection with consideration and action on applications for abatements sec.1B, Chairman Laggis called for a vote to go into Executive Session with Open Session to reconvene at the conclusion of the Executive Session. IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby required to levy on and collect from the several persons named in the excise list herewith committed to you the amount of the MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAILER EXCISE assessed to each such person for the privilege of registration, as therein set forth, with interest, the sum total of such list being Six Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty Five dollars and Four cents (\$6,735.04).

And you are to pay over said excises and interest to **Barbara Tierney**, **Treasurer of Ayer**, or to her successor in office, at the times and in the manner provided by General Laws, Chapter 60, Section 2, and also to give to the treasurer as aforesaid an account of all charges and fees collected by you. And you are to make written return of said excises and interest with your excise list and of your doings thereon at such times as the assessors shall in writing require.

But you are to complete, and make up an account of, the collection of the whole sum hereby committed to you, with interest, on or before December 31 of the current year.

And if a person refuses or neglects to pay his excise for fourteen days after demand, you shall issue a warrant to collect said excise including interest, charges and fees. If a person refuses or neglects to pay his excise after you or your designee have notified the person by mail or other means that a warrant to collect has been issued, and you or your designee have exhibited a copy of the said warrant to collect, or delivered a copy thereof to the taxpayer, or left it at his last and usual place of abode, or of business, you or your designee may request a hearing in the district court having jurisdiction. If the court finds that the debt is owed and there is sufficient property and an ability to pay, a warrant to distrain or commit and take the body of such person and commit him to jail shall issue to you or your designee shall proceed to enforce the collection of said excise in accordance with the provisions of said court warrant.

And in the levy and collection of the amounts hereby committed to you, and of interest, and charges, and fees as provided by law, you are to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of this Commonwealth upon collectors of taxes.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby required to levy on and collect from the several persons named in the tax list herewith committed to you the amount of the tax assessed to each person on **RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE** as therein set forth, with interest, the sum total of such list being **One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Four dollars and Sixty Seven cents (\$114,254.67)**, which is the whole amount to all persons known to us to be liable to taxation on **Residential Real Estate** situated in Ayer, for state, county, city or town purposes, and for overlay.

And you are to pay over said taxes and interest to **Barbara Tierney**, **Treasurer** of **Ayer**, or to her successor in office, at the times and in the manner provided by General Laws, Chapter 60, Section 2, and also to give to the Treasurer as aforesaid an account of all charges and fees collected by you. And you are to make written return of said taxes and interest with your tax list and of your doings thereon at such times as the assessors shall in writing require.

But you are to complete, and make up an account of, the collection of the whole sum hereby committed to you, with interest, on or before June 30 of the fiscal year to which the tax list relates.

And if a person refuses or neglects to pay his tax for fourteen days after demand, you shall issue a warrant to collect said tax including interest, charges and fees. If a person refuses or neglects to pay his tax after you or your designee have notified the person by mail or other means that a warrant to collect has been issued, and you or your designee have exhibited a copy of the said warrant to collect, or delivered a copy thereof to the taxpayer, or left it at his last and usual place of abode, or of business, you or your designee may request a hearing in the district court having jurisdiction. If the court finds that the debt is owed and there is sufficient property and an ability to pay, a warrant to distrain or commit and take the body of such person and commit him to jail shall issue to you or your designee to serve upon said person, according to law. Upon the issuance of the warrant to distrain or commit, you or your designee shall proceed to enforce the collection of said tax in accordance with the provisions of said court warrant.

And in the levy and collection of the amounts hereby committed to you, and of interest, and charges, and fees as provided by law, you are to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of this Commonwealth upon collectors of taxes.
