## Water and Sewer Enterprise Funds

- •Both the Water and Wastewater Divisions are funded through Enterprise Funds
- Communities establish enterprise funds for business-type services
- •Essentially, funding is based on the services provided as opposed to coming from the tax base
- In the cases of the water and sewer Enterprise Funds, water is metered and property owner is billed at the current water and sewer rates
- •Each year, a Rate Model is utilized for the Rate Review Committee to review and recommend rates to the Select Board
- March 19<sup>th</sup> Select Board Public Hearing with Rate Review Committee for vote of recommended water and sewer rates for FY25



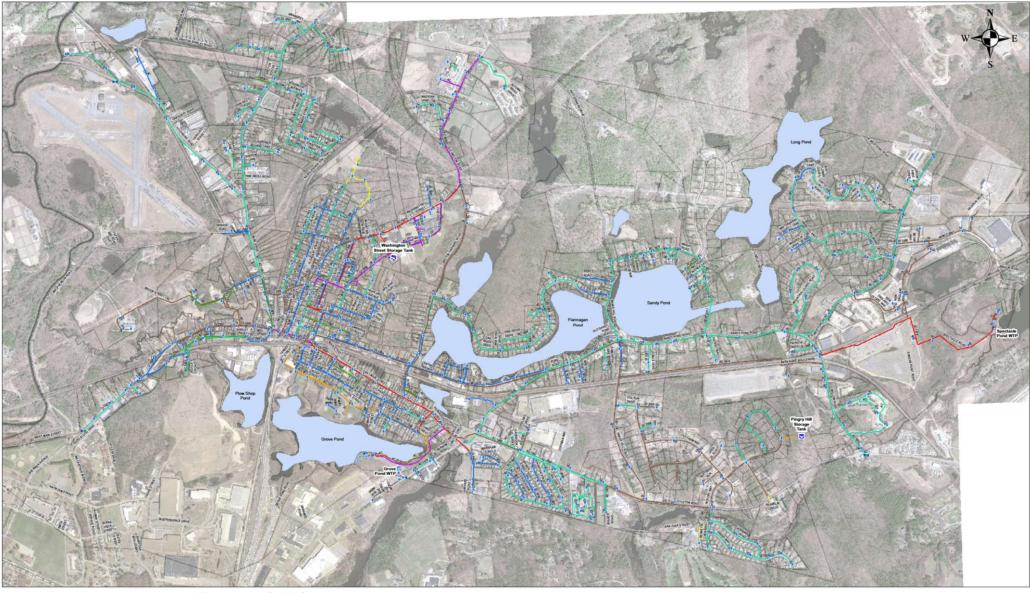

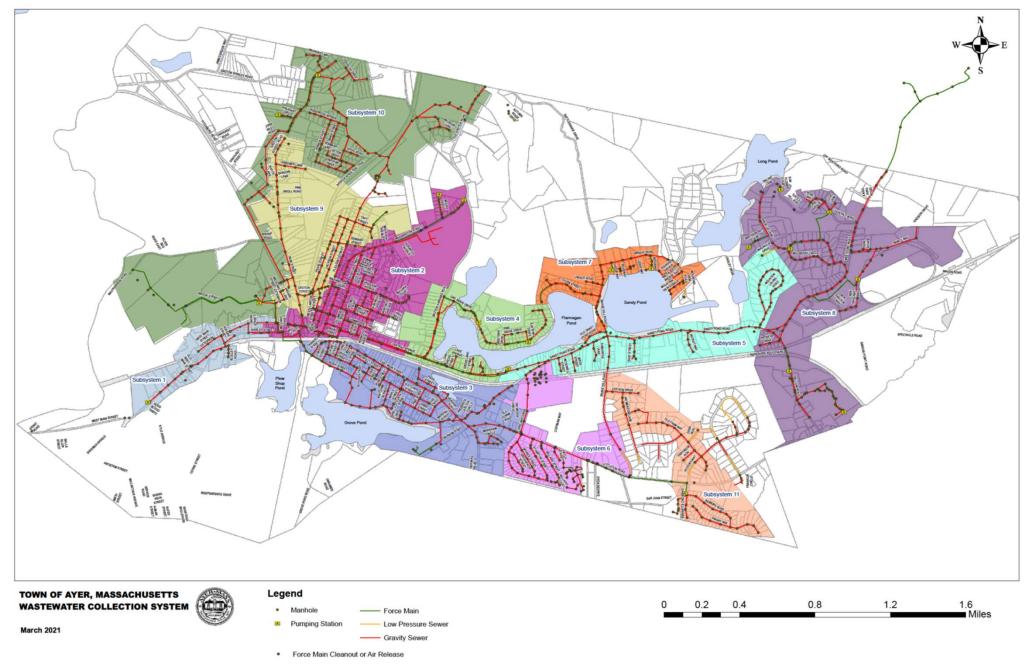
