

- i. Purchase of recycling equipment, as specified.
 → No idea where to find the "as specified" list
- ii. Procurement of environmentally preferable cleaning products, equipment and supplies from specified categories via <u>Massachusetts State Contract</u> <u>FAC85</u>.

→Includes rain barrels, which we've talked about, and compost bins. We could buy more compost bins to give away to schools and other non-profits.

Transportation and recycling of specific "hard to recycle" materials, including automotive wastes, bulky rigid plastics, consumer electronics, mercury-added products and more.

 \rightarrow I interpret this to mean that I can pay for the truck we rent to haul Styro from RYR.

- iv. Improvements to recycling collection infrastructure and sites at select locations.
- v. Production of waste reduction/recycling promotional materials.
- vi. Enhancement of school waste reduction programs. \rightarrow I will talk to the schools about this.
