I. Facility History

The Ayer Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) was constructed in 1982. Miscellaneous upgrades have been implemented since, including:

- 1994 ceramic fine bubble diffusers and blower building added
- 2007 process improvements including grit, tertiary, anoxic tanks, tank conversion,
 addition of ultraviolet (UV) disinfection and disk filters; electrical and controls upgrades
- 2011 UV system replacement, energy upgrade

II. Project Overview

The primary focus of the FY2018 Improvements is to address aging building systems and safety concerns. Work includes electrical, HVAC, and plumbing systems improvements; architectural and structural modifications and improvements; miscellaneous instrumentation and communications modifications; and demolition of the existing belt filter press, including concrete curbing. A detailed discussion of the project was not included given the wide variety of work to be done.

Attention is called to the potential for asbestos abatement associated with work on HVAC piping insulation and existing water service.

III. Maintenance of Plant Operations (MOPO)

Due to the scope of the contract, no service interruptions at the WWTF are anticipated. Specification Section 01810 should be carefully reviewed. Work in the office area shall be scheduled and executed in a manner that minimizes interruptions and period of time the office cannot be occupied.

Power supply disruption shall be coordinated with the Owner and Engineer, shall occur at a period of low flow, and shall be minimized to the maximum extent possible. Flow can be sent to the Devens WWTF during this period.

IV. Schedule

- Pre-bid Meeting: April 3, 2018, 9:30 a.m. Ayer WWTF
- Filed Sub-bid Opening: April 12, 2018, 2:00 p.m. Ayer Department of Public Works
 - Filed sub-bid categories include fire protection sprinkler systems, plumbing, HVAC, and electrical.

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- General Bid Opening: May 3, 2018, 2:00 p.m. Ayer Department of Public Works
- Contract Duration: 240 calendar days commencing 20 day following Effective Date of Agreement (180 calendar days to substantial completion).
- Liquidated Damages will be assessed for work beyond the contract duration.

V. Funding

Project is funded locally (not CWSRF). Bidding and Award of this Contract will be under provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 149, Section 44A-44J. All bidders (general bidders and filed subbidders) must have current certificate of eligibility issued by the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance.

VI. Miscellaneous Issues

- 1. **Staging Areas and Temporary Facilities** –The Town requires constant accessibility to all facilities at the site. The designated staging area is shown on the drawings. Engineer's temporary field office shall be supplied by Contractor in accordance with Section 01500.
- 2. **Submittals** Independent hosted web-based electronic system shall be by Submittal Exchange or equal. Contractor is responsible for obtaining.
- 3. **Questions and Attendee List -** It was noted that only questions submitted in writing and responded to by Addenda will be binding. Oral responses should not be considered binding. Bidders were advised to submit questions in writing to Matthew Pitta (PittaMD@cdmsmith.com). Attendees to the pre-bid conference were requested to sign the attendee list available at the pre-bid conference; the list is attached.
- 4. **Addenda** No addenda have been issued to date. It was noted that notes from the prebid conference meeting and attendee list will be distributed via addenda.
- 5. **Utility Coordination** Payment for work done by National Gird to provide new electrical service to the site, including pad mounted transformer and meter will be made directly by the Town. The Contractor is responsible for contact, coordination, and scheduling work.





- Q1. Are we correct in our interpretation of the Division 16 electrical specification paragraph 16720.1.01.C requirement? If the following is a correct interpretation wouldn't an allowance be a better approach? The electrical filed sub-bidder is to include the expense of an ERRC study to determine the need for an ERRC installation which might not even be necessary. The electrical filed sub-bidder is to include the expense for an ERRC installation. The ERRC installation expense is just in case on is determined to be required by the study performed for this project?
- **A1**. Refer to Addendum No. 1 for modifications to Specification Section 16720.
- **Q2.** Is the Division 16 electrical specification paragraph 16720.1.01.D requirement referring to the ERRC installation or possibly the Radio Master Box?
- **A2.** Specification Section 16720, Paragraph 1.01(D) is in reference to the radio master box. This work is to make sure that the radio antennae that is installed will properly communicate with the Town of Ayer FD system.

- Q3. The prints show 1200a, but from our pictures it seems the existing switch is rated for 1600a. Is the intent to just refeed with 1200A, and keep the 4th conduit a spare?
