**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this meeting is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed intersection improvements on Route 2A at Willow Road and Bruce Street project. All views and comments made at the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

**PROPOSAL:** The proposed project consists of intersection improvements, including geometric modifications, widening and signalization at the intersection of Route 2A/ 110 at Willow Road/ Bruce Street.

Written views received by MassDOT subsequent to the date of this notice and up to five (5) days prior to the date of the meeting shall be displayed for public inspection and copying at the time and date listed above. Concepts will be on display one-half hour before the meeting begins, with an engineer in attendance to answer questions regarding this project.
