### \*Meeting Highlights from the February 16, 2016 Ayer Board of Selectmen

- The BOS was called to order at 7:15pm.
- The BOS received a hand-carved wooden shield from Africa from Fire Lt. Charles Dillion as a symbol of gratitude to the Town for all of its support during his military career.
- There was no Public Input.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to appoint a Reserve Police Officer.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to adopt the Town of Ayer Complete Streets Policy as presented by the DPW Superintendent.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to authorize the Order of Takings for several streets accepted at the 2015 Fall Special Town Meeting.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to hire a DPW Utility Position as recommended by the DPW Superintendent.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to hire the Administrative Coordinator Position as recommended by the Town Administrator.
- The BOS set its March meeting schedule as follows: March 8, 2016, 7pm and March 22, 2016, 7pm.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to authorize a letter of support for the Sandy Pond School Association's application for Community Preservation Funds.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to open the Annual Town Meeting Warrant. All warrant articles including Citizens Petitions are due by 12pm (Noon) on Friday, April 8, 2016.
- The BOS discussed the FY 2017 Budget with the Town Administrator.
- The BOS voted (2-0) to approve the February 2, 2016 meeting minutes
- The BOS adjourned at 8:49pm.
