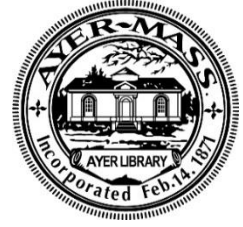


Ayer Board of Selectmen

*Meeting Highlights from January 5, 2016



- The Ayer Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 7pm.
- The Board was joined by the Town of Littleton Board of Selectmen to conduct a public informational meeting regarding the Willow Road/Route 2A Intersection. The Boards made a presentation on a proposal to reconfigure and signalize this intersection. The Boards took comments and questions from the Public. A similar meeting will be held by both Boards in the Town of Littleton at 6:30pm on January 11, 2016 at the Littleton Town Offices.
- The Board heard a report and administrative update from the Town Administrator.
- The Board voted (2-0) to appoint several Detail Officers as recommended by the Police Chief to a term of one year.
- The Board voted (2-0) to appoint a resident to the Recycling Committee.
- The Board voted (2-0) to appoint the Town Administrator as the Town's voting delegate at the Massachusetts Municipal Annual Meeting on January 23, 2016.
- The Board reviewed an update on the status of the 2015-2016 Town Administrator's goals and objectives. The Town Administrator reported that all 2015-2016 goals and objectives are on schedule for completion by July 1, 2016.
- The Board voted (2-0) to approve the December 15, 2015 meeting minutes.
- The Board adjourned at 8:15pm.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Ayer Board of Selectmen will be on Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall.
