***Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for March 8, 2016**

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for March 8, 2016 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS approved (3-0) a Reserve Fund Transfer in the amount of \$12,872 from the Police Chief for the hiring of a Radio Consultant to develop a solution to the police radio system.
- The BOS approved the following Non-Union Personnel Position Reclassifications on recommendation of the Personnel Board and Town Administrator as follows:
(2-1) DPW Superintendent GRADE 16 STEP 7 effective July 1, 2016;
(3-0) Director of Parks & Recreation GRADE 11 STEP 4 effective July 1, 2016;
(3-0) Town Engineer GRADE 12 STEP 8 effective July 1, 2016; and
(2-1) DPW Business Manager GRADE 9 effective July 1, 2016
- The BOS heard an administrative report and update from the Town Administrator.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approved Amendment #3 to the Devens Household Hazardous Waste Center Contract which will admit the Town of Stow into the Center.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize a letter of support to be sent to the State Delegation for the Massachusetts Municipal Modernization Bill.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint Selectman Gary J. Luca as the Town's primary representative to the Montachusett Planning Organization (MPO) and the Town Administrator as the alternate representative.
- The BOS discussed and agreed to the formation of a Formal Town Bylaw Review working group to work with the firm MuniCode to review and make recommendations with respect to the Town's Bylaws. Any recommendations requiring changes to the Bylaws will require Town Meeting approval.
- The BOS discussed its summer meeting schedule.
- The BOS discussed potential traffic improvements for sections Columbia Street, Newton Street, Central Ave, and Main Street. The BOS approved (3-0) on recommendation from the Police Chief, "No U-Turn" signage for the intersection of Main Street and Columbia Street.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the February 9, 2016 and February 16, 2016 BOS Meeting Minutes.
- The BOS Adjourned from Open Session at approximately 9:15pm to go into Executive Session and adjourned for the evening from the Executive Session.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOS will be on Wednesday, March 23, 2016 at 7pm at the Ayer Town Hall
