*Ayer Board of Selectmen Meeting Highlights for November 15, 2016

- The Ayer Board of Selectmen (BOS) Meeting for Nov. 15, 2016 was called to order at 7pm.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint a police patrol officer on recommendation of the Chief. The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint a prisoner watch personnel. The Chief reported that he is working on a truck exclusion for Columbia Street on request of the BOS. The BOS discussed with the Chief the potential implications of the new marijuana law that passed the ballot last Tuesday.
- The BOS heard several reports from the Economic Development Department regarding the 2016 Holiday Stroll and Tree Lighting; Main Street MBTA Fence Project Update; Former Fire Station RFP Update. The BOS discussed the proposed walking path project for Pirone Park.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize the relocation of the two tenants of the USO/Advocates Building. The BOS voted (3-0) to authorize MART to demolish the building for the purposes of Commuter Rail Surface Parking Lot and Access Improvement Project.
- The BOS approved (3-0) a 1-Day Outdoor Beer and Wine License for Carlin's on Nov. 23, 2016. The BOS voted (3-0) to appoint the Town Administrator as the Town's Public Records Officer in accordance with the new public records law(s). The BOS appointed (3-0) two individuals to one year terms on the Memorial Garden Committee.
- The BOS voted (3-0) to approve the Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2016.
- The BOS adjourned (3-0) from Open Session at approximately 9:00pm to enter into an Executive Session.
