- The Board recognized the Broncos Cheerleading Team for winning the American Youth Cheering National Championship in Florida.

- The Board voted (2-0) to approve a change order for the Stony Brook Wastewater Pumping Station.
- The Board received a presentation from the DPW Superintendent and Town Engineer on the conditions of the Shirley Street Bridge and West Main Street Culvert and voting (2-0) to authorize the use of UDAG Grant Funds up to \$100,000 for the design and engineering for these bridges.
- The Board received a presentation from the DPW Superintendent on the MassDOT's Complete Streets Program.
- The Board voted (2-0) to approve the Personnel Board's Classification of the Police Department Records Clerk at a Grade 3.
- The Board received the Town Administrator's Report and Administrative Update.
- The Board voted (2-0) to approve the January 5, 2016 meeting minutes.
