

#### What Did We Do Last Year?

- Completed Pleasant Street Reconstruction
- Completed Spec Pond Replacement Well
- Replaced drainage system and repaved road and sidewalks on Washington Street
- Repaved New England Way
- Constructed Stormwater BMPs/ Rain Gardens at 3 locations



- Completed Water Main loop from Sandy Pond Rd to Wright Road
- Replaced old water services on Snake Hill Rd
- Constructed DPW Operations Center
- Replaced Streetlights with LED lights (65% energy savings) – Paid for with Green Community Grant
- Started construction of Dog Park (opening in June!)






- Started first year of Ayer DPW YouthWorks Program
- Designed West Main St Bridge (ready to go to bid)
- Completed Phase 1 of Sewer System Evaluation
- Started construction of Ayer Dog Park
- Designed and Bid Phase 1 of wastewater treatment plant upgrade
