During the month of January 2014 the Police Department logged 634 events requiring 52 incident reports and 11 arrest reports. We assisted the Fire Department on 41 medicals and 16 fire alarms. Here are some of the highlights:

The Department, through the efforts of Lt. Brian Gill, received a \$10,000.00 grant from the State 911 Department. These monies will be used to send Dispatchers to training and to pay for the replacement overtime costs.

From a Pedestrian Safety Grant obtained by Officer Richard Krasinskas we received four Crosswalk signs that will be installed to try to increase awareness of the presence of crosswalks. The crosswalks to be targeted are: Main @ Pleasant, Columbia at the Post Office, East Main at the Courthouse/Library, and Sandy Pond Road at the Beach.
