- Taco Bell Building is under full scale renovation employment solicitations have been posted made a number of attempts to contact corporate to get opening day information nothing received yet
- Global Fuel and Convenience Location I was be in attendance at the Zoning Meeting for the Global requests due to some negative comments from the Zoning Board and neighbors, Global rescinded their original requests and will be rescheduling with the Zoning board in the near future.

- Available property Currently there are three locations available: Spaulding Building, 1200 sq.ft. rear of Fletcher Building, 600 sq. ft within the Berry Block
- New Subway is currently in the interior build-out process I will monitor the BOH activities as the shop gets closer to opening The owner has been soliciting for employees
