- December 1st a bid opening was held at the Fire Station for the Ambulance Billing Contract.
 Coastal Medical Billing; the incumbent was selected as the successful bidder. A contract for services was signed at the December 16th Selectman's meeting giving Coastal the contract for three years with an option for a fourth year.
- December 5th a grant was submitted to the Department of Homeland Security; Assistance to
 Firefighters program for a new Cardiac Monitor for A-2. This would replace the existing Life Pac
 12 monitor with an updated Life Pac 15. The Life Pac 15 has many technological advantages over
 the Life Pac 12. There would be a 5% grant match for the cost of this unit. The department hopes
 for a successful outcome for this was a lengthy and technical grant application.
