- In February Call Firefighter Tyler Schwabe started Call Volunteer Firefighter I/II training at the Massachusetts State Fire Academy in Stow. This class meets two weeknights and both weekend days each week ending the last week in June. Basic firefighting skills are taught by state certified instructors. Certifications are gained in hazardous materials and firefighter I/II meeting national requirements. This class is offered free at the Fire Academy to all members of fire departments in the State. The Town is lucky to have had several members of this department participate in this training and become certified firefighters. It is a large commitment in time for the participant.
- In February the Chief attended a three day conference at the Worcester Centrum. This training opportunity is offered yearly by the Massachusetts Fire Chiefs Association. Classes in fire department management are taught by instructors both national and international. One interesting class was instructed by the Chief of training for the Frankfort, Germany fire department. This class highlighting the differences in training of recruit firefighters between the U.S. and Germany.
