During the month of April 2017 the Police Department logged 790 events requiring 33 incident reports and 11 arrest reports. We assisted the Fire Department on 50 medicals and 8 fire alarms. Here are some of the highlights:

Radio Follow-up: Contract negotiations with our engineer are ongoing. Once secured we can continue with the RPF process and a presentation at Town Meeting for Phase II.

Our new radio shelter building was delivered and set in place this month. There was minor damage to the AC system which occurred while in storage and is guaranteed to be repaired by the seller.

The Fire Chief and I presented a training to Town Hall employees on fire escape plans and handling bomb threats.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> we received notice that we had won a Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant, \$3,583.00, from EOPSS. The grant will allow us to purchase equipment and conduct extra enforcement.
