Re: July Monthly Report

During the month of July 2017 the Police Department logged 781 events requiring 31 incident reports and 10 arrest reports. We assisted the Fire Department on 58 medicals and 7 fire alarms. Here are some of the highlights:

Radio Follow-up: Contract negotiations have been successfully concluded. We have begun the RPF process and hope to see the beginnings of construction this fall.
