Re: February Monthly Report

During the month of February 2018 the Police Department logged 656 events requiring 32 incident reports and 9 arrest reports. We assisted the Fire Department on 67 medicals and 19 fire alarms. Here are some of the highlights:

Radio Follow-up: Timberline has started work at the hospital, since it's inside work, to install equipment that will boost reception inside the building. The other sites have been put on hold until Planning Board and ZBA approvals have been received.

In conjunction with the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD), we conducted a yearly Point in Time homeless count the evening of the 31st and early morning of Feb. 1. DHCD asks all municipalities in the State to conduct these counts as part of a grant that would offer resources to those in need. This year we reported 2 homeless but both have local resources they rely on in the cold weather.
