## MONTHLY REPORT SELECTMEN FIRE DEPARTMENT JANUARY 2016

- Due to the retirement of Captain Taylor in December there was an open slot for a Captain on shift two. The Union contract has a promotional process to follow for promotion to higher ranks. That process was started in October with the posting of an examination date and the list of promotional references to study from. There is a ninety day study period that culminated with a test on January nineteenth. Each Lieutenant is allowed to test for Captain and with a passing score granted an interview. Four personnel entered into the testing process; all received a passing score on the test and were interviewed by a panel of five area Chiefs the next day. Lieutenant Jeremy Januskiewicz attained the highest score in the testing process and was promoted to Captain on January 28<sup>th</sup>. The promotion of Jeremy Januskiewicz to Captain left an open slot for a Lieutenant. Firefighter Paramedic David Greenwood was promoted to Lieutenant on January 28<sup>th</sup> to fill that open spot. This promotion was done of an existing promotional list. David will be the Fire Prevention Lieutenant; a day position, replacing Lieutenant John Bresnahan who elected to go back onto a twenty four hour shift rotation. I am pleased with the comprehensiveness of the testing and the fairness of the process. If you see either one of the newly promoted personnel please congratulate them on their achievement.
