

**MONTHLY REPORT SELECT BOARD
FIRE DEPARTMENT JUNE 2020**

- With the passing of the Fire Department budget at the Annual Town Meeting on June 15th the first fulltime Deputy Chief position was created within the Fire Department rank structure. The senior Captain Timothy Johnston was appointed to the position effective July 1st. This is an important position to have within the department to assist the Chief with the day to day duties and will allow the Chief to mentor a candidate for succession planning. The moving up of Captain Johnston left an open space for a Lieutenant to move up to Captain resulting in an open Lieutenants position. Both positions were filled from a promotional list that was created when Captain Fillebrown left the department to accept the Chief's position in Boxborough. On July 1st Lieutenant John Bresnahan was promoted to Captain on Shift 1 and Firefighter Brenton Bourne was promoted to Lieutenant on Shift 2. To fill the open position on Shift 2 an internal job posting was placed for 10 days with-in the Call Department for a fulltime Firefighter/Paramedic. Two application were received, and interviews are being conducted the second week in July.
