 - o Bond amount: \$6,175,000.00
 - o Awarded To: Piper Sandler & Co
 - o Premium received. The amount after paying the Cost of issuance is \$432,442.00
 - o The Premium was used to pay down some of the projects borrowing for. Attached is an overview showing the various projects along with the application of premium, (highlighted in yellow across the bottom of each project). By applying the premium in this manner, it saves about \$500,000.00 in future interest cost.
