# **Director's Report for November 2021 Ayer Senior Center / Council on Aging**

11.22.21

## **Physical Space:**

The staff and seniors are thrilled by the Senior Center's new, inviting look. New paint, flooring, reception and dining furniture have transformed the Senior Center into a warm and welcoming place to engage, learn, exercise, and eat.

#### Kitchen/Meals:

One Day Permits were submitted for each of the 10 special meals planned between now and the end of the year, funded by the COVID-19 grant. The large freezer was defrosted. Congregate meals resumed 11/8, with attendance ranging between 5 for MOC meals and 30 for special meals.

#### Software:

The MySeniorCenter software purchase was funded through a reserve fund transfer and staff will be trained on the new system on 12/17.

#### **Newsletter:**

The newsletter produced through the existing vendor was unacceptable for distribution and was reprinted on the Town Hall and COA printers. We will be seeking release from our contract and continue to print in-house.

#### **Programming:**

The Senior Center re-opened November 1. It will take time to ramp up programming and learn what the seniors want & need, but we have a steady and increasing following for exercise and meals. The business model for running the Center is being evaluated.

### **Transportation:**

MART continues to push for dispatch and driver regionalization. The Senior Center will begin using QRyde software for ride scheduling & manifests beginning December 1. The software has some bugs and unfinished features. No commitment has been made to regionalizing rides.

## **Budget:**

Spending is on track thus far. Changes will be needed for the upcoming fiscal year to accommodate a full re-opening and new priorities for the Senior Center.

The CDBG COVID grant (\$4500) for food delivery has received a verbal blessing from Economic & Community Development to be used for congregate meals.

#### Miscellaneous:

- COA staff and board are all eager to begin work on a new Senior Center
- Publicity: social media & town website content are being reviewed and updated.
- Volunteers: once the physical improvements and operations have stabilized, we'll be looking for volunteers and senior tax work off workers
