## Conservation Commission Monthly Report July 2022

The Commission continues to have a variety of work ranging from site inspections on new projects to visiting and following up on projects that are currently in various stages of construction.

At the two Conservation Commissions meetings this month the Commission approved two small projects, one on Oak Ridge Drive and one on Littleton Road. The Commission also hired and met with their consultant from BSC Group who will review the proposed subdivision project known as Stratton Hill. Their review will look at the Conservation Analysis and will assist the Commission in writing their recommendation to the Planning Board. The Commission will meet with the consultant on site and will have them back to a meeting to review their report in August.

The Conservation Agent met with several residents to discuss the removal of dead, damaged or dangerous trees on their property for removal. The Agent also continues to visit the Ayer Solar II project to ensure the site is stable and in compliance with their permit.

Going into August the Conservation Office is expecting an application for the soil remediation at Pirone Park as well as an application for the Spectacle Pond Water Treatment Plant.
