### Goals


- The Town of Ayer began this process to co-locate all existing bylaws and regulations for ease of use and increased navigation abilities on our website.



# Timeline

- Town Meeting approved Article 22 of the 5/8/2017 ATM authorized \$20,000 for code review and update of Town's Bylaws
- Town contracted with General Code and convened internal working group consisting of Selectman Jannice Livingston, Assistant Town Manager Carly Antonellis, Town Clerk Susan Copeland and Police Chief Bill Murray.
- Town provided all existing Bylaws and Regulations to General Code for research, editorial and legal review to identify conflicts and inconsistencies; the creation of an index; the preparation of the newly organized code "Bylaws and Regulations of the Town of Ayer, Massachusetts"

# Timeline, continued

- Beginning in June of 2017, the Town of Ayer's internal working group and General Code set out on the process to the right
- All Departments were integral in various parts of this process, reviewing their respective bylaws and regulations to ensure accuracy
- \*Important to Note All general content remains the same unless found to be in violation of state or federal law



# Sample of Code

### Chapter 85

#### TOWN MEETINGS

§ 85-1. Dates for annual meetings.

§ 85-5. Eligibility for attendance.

§ 85-2. Notice.

§ 85-6. Authority of Moderator in supermajority votes.

§ 85-3. Annual Town Election.

§ 85-4. Quorum.

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Meeting of the Town of Ayer as Art. I of the Bylaws. Amendments noted where applicable.]

#### § 85-1. Dates for annual meetings. [Amended 10-28-2019 STM by Art. 14]

The Annual Town Meeting shall be held on the fourth Monday of April each year. The Special Annual Fall Meeting shall be held at 7:00 in the evening on the fourth Monday in October of each year.

#### § 85-2. Notice.

Every Town Meeting shall be notified by posting attested copies of the warrant calling the same in three or more public places, one of which shall be the Town Hall. Notice of the Annual Town Meeting shall be posted seven days at least before the day appointed for said meeting; and notice of a Special Town Meeting must be posted at least 14 days before the meeting.

#### § 85-3. Annual Town Election. [Amended 10-28-2019 STM by Art. 14]

The Annual Town Election shall be held on the second Tuesday of May, with the polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

#### § 85-4. Quorum.

The number of voters necessary to constitute a quorum at Town Meetings shall be 50.
